## Idolatry

"Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry."

Colossians 3:5

Far and away, the greatest sin in the Bible is idolatry. Idolatry is the main reason why God rebuked and judged the nation of Israel. Most of us limit our understanding of idolatry to antiquated practices of worshiping pagan images. Be advised that idolatry occurs frequently in our modern world and extends beyond images.

Idolatry occurs whenever a person violates the first of the Ten Commandments, which declares, "You shall have no other gods before Me" (Exodus 20:3). It takes place when we put something or someone before God in our life. Idolatry is the root cause of all other sins which explains why the first two Commandments deal with it. Too often, the church focuses on sins related to human sexuality, lifestyle choices, and mistreatment of others while ignoring the greatest commandment - idolatry.

Idolatry has always been the major downfall of people. Current idols are more subtle than ancient ones. Popular modern idols take the form of people, possessions, status, and self-aggrandizement. Beware of bowing down to these things. False gods never satisfy; instead, they stir up passion for more and more. When you seek Jesus Christ rather than the world's idols, you experience His joy (*John 15:11*) and peace (*John 14:27*). Only the intangibles which Jesus offers satisfy your soul and make you a beacon through whom others are drawn to Him. Check your "idolatry meter" and toss out those things ruining your relationship with Christ.
