## Vacation Bible School Begins Next Week!

Next Monday, June 19 is the beginning of our largest children's outreach program, Vacation Bible School. The theme this year is "Maker Fun Factory - Created by God-built for a purpose." We are preparing for 250 children with a staff of 120 volunteers! Each day the children will be introduced to one Bible point. They include God made you, God is for you, God is always with you, God will always love you, and God made you for a reason. The daily theme is reinforced at each of the stations the children visit: Bible story, music, snack, recreation, KidVid (video testimonies), and crafts. The Bible buddy tags which include Decker (Decorator Crab), Tina (termite), Bubba (Humpback whale), Skylar (bowerbird), and Abbee (a rare bee) feature the day's key Bible verse and the Bible point. Each child takes a set home as a reminder of those verses. The children will be encouraged to support the two mission projects for the week: art supplies for the Hope Food Pantry and money that will be donated to help build the Joy in Haiti church. The fun week ends with the closing program at 6:30 p.m. on Friday, June 23 in the CLC. EVERYONE is invited to come, see, and hear what the children have learned. Please pray for all the children and workers each day that week. Our hope and prayer is that the message of Jesus is spoken, heard, and received and that lives will be changed because of their week at VBS.
